
Our Vision


Our neighbourhood will be a *viGrant* and **Safe** place to be.

Horticultural Apprenticeship

- Community Involvement & Support

 - Ealing Council YJS
 - Ealing Council Connexions Pathways
 - initially Accession now Cultivate London
- Meeting identified needs
 - lack of local training and employment opportunities
 - underused green spaces and communal garden
 - crime and anti-social behaviour
 - reduced health and wellbeing
 - losing cultural identity



Getting Match funding

HBL contribution over 3 years £55,500 Matched funding gained £144,000
