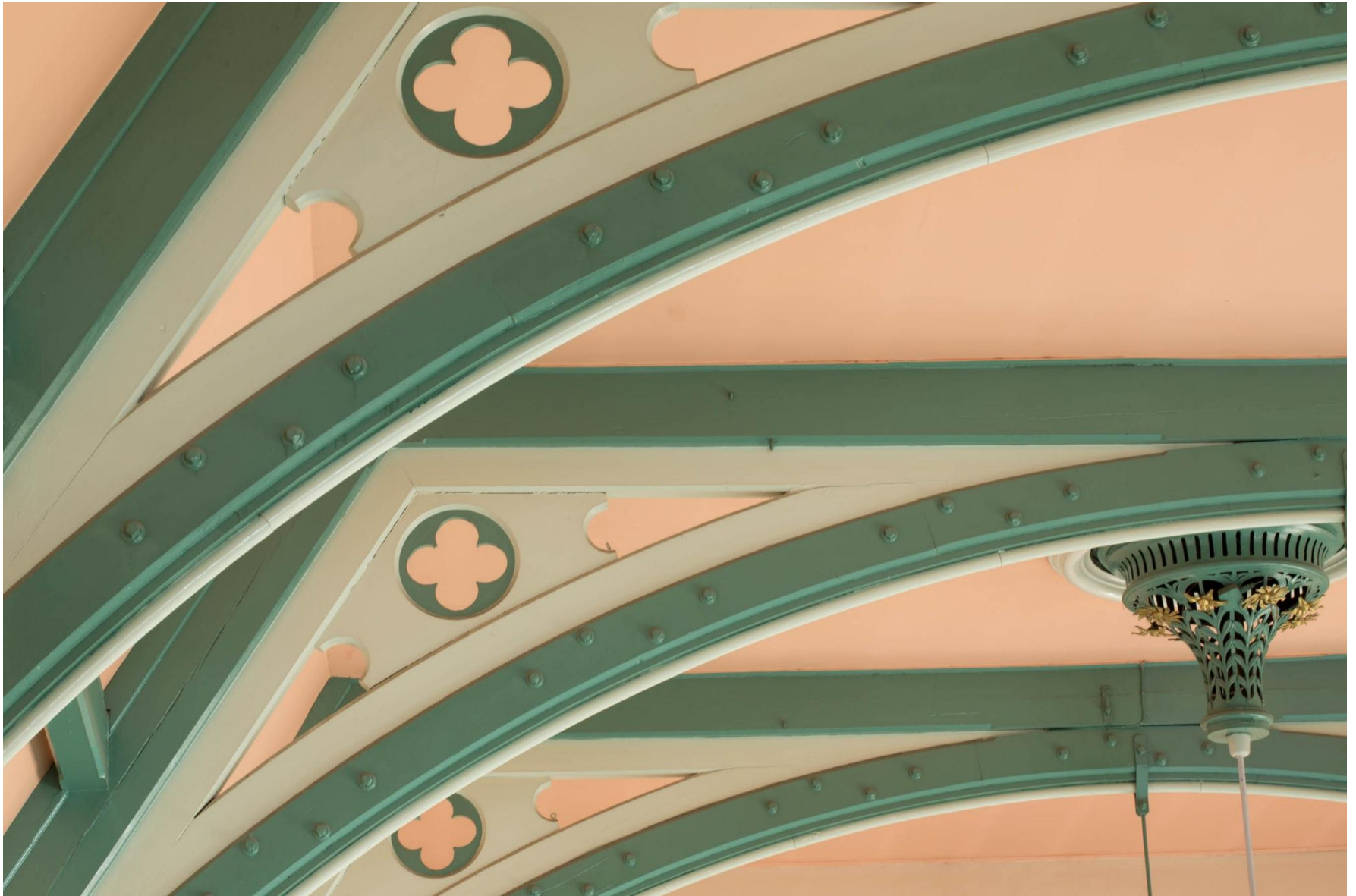

A TABLE top sale organised as part of an ongoing campaign to restore a Victorian landmark to its former glory has raised more than £3,000.
