Number of Authorised Building Societies







- National programme to reduce isolation and loneliness in people over 50
- 32 areas on the shortlist. 15-20 would be successful
- Up to £6 million investment available for our area
- Core partnership formed and developed a vision for our city
- All sectors needed to be involved and support the Sheffield bid
- Only HA led bid in the country. Secured the full £6 million. Highest performer at tender and on the programme



Isolation and Ioneliness

- One of the biggest public health challenges facing our society
- Demonstrable health impact and cause of higher rates of mortality
- Risk of death comparable to well-established risks such as smoking and alcohol consumption
- Family dispersal and demographic developments are increasing the scale of the issue
- By intervening early we can limit dependence on more costly services




