- Providing prisoners to help with community clean up, to tidy up and paint railings in the shopping centre.
- Prisoners also helped to create a small garden area within the community.
- Worked with children and young people to make bird boxes.
- Creating an amazing buffet for volunteers at the end of the week of action.

Supporting our Community Café:

- By providing £10,000 for the first year's rent
- Providing prisoners released on temporary licence (ROTL) to work in our café 5 days a week. Helping them adjust to life on the outside ready for when they are released back into the community
- With good ties to other organisations and linking us up with others who can help us to develop our projects such as Community Payback, Probation Service, Job Centre Plus
- Providing prisoners to undertake some of the internal alterations and building work in the café to get it up and running

- Took on the lease for the Community Café for the first two years.
- Employing the Café Manager and Community Development Worker on our behalf.
- Supporting WestRaven Big Local to develop the community café and the growing space

 - energy saving initiatives
 - community activities
 - cooking projects
 - bicycle powered cinema to name but a few
